The Newark Energy Center (previously known as the HESS Plant) changed their plan. The NEC is requesting two new permits that will result in SIGNIFICANT increase to local air pollution.

NEC plans to use 4-times the amount of toxic chemicals than what they originally proposed.

NEC plans to make changes to their smoke stack heights and diameters.
NEC has not released their emergency plans to the public.
