## Changes the Plan: Increases Health Risk

The Newark Energy Center (previously known as the HESS Plant) changed their plan. The NEC is requesting two new permits that will result in **SIGNIFICANT** increase to local air pollution.

- NEC plans to use 4-times the amount of toxic chemicals than what they originally proposed.
- NEC plans to make changes to their smoke stack heights and diameters.
- NEC has not released their emergency plans to the public.
